

## 2019 Top Resource Sharing Libraries

Libraries in Indiana are classed by the size of their resident tax base. Libraries serving communities of up to 10,000 residents are Class C. Class B libraries serve communities ranging in size from 10,001-40,000 residents. Class A libraries serve communities of more than 40,000 residents.
