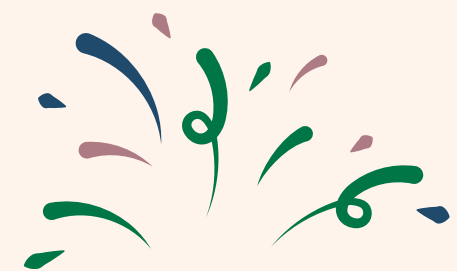
ANNIVERSARIES
